CHIEF pilot and Floating Images managing director Graeme Day is celebrating 18 years of service to the Ipswich community.

The familiar sight of the hot air balloon early in the morning has delighted about 15,000.

Mr Day said the past 18 years has been an amazing and proud journey.

Mr Day and his passengers have spent around 1800 hours above Ipswich City, the Scenic Rim and Somerset regions.

"I have watched how Ipswich has grown and changed from above. Ipswich is normally a very green city, not a concrete jungle," Mr Day said.

"We have even had family reunions, anniversaries, proposals and weddings. The corporate market uses us for marketing functions or networking events. Experiencing a hot air balloon is a great way to do these things."

Mr Day is proud of the achievements of this small family business.

"Floating Images Hot Air Balloon Flights is Ipswich's longest-running aviation adventure tourism business, and the first ballooning operator to offer hot air balloon flights in Ipswich and Somerset and the Scenic Rim region," he said.

"We do have experience vouchers; these are gift vouchers that you can buy. They make a great gift and at this time of year, people do get these for a Christmas gift."
